Worship Idea: You are a "GEM"

March 13 is National Jewel Day. Celebrate by wearing your favorite jewels or perhaps make some jewelry, but celebrate the fact that as God's daughter you are a GEM to Him—you are precious to and treasured by Him.

G – God Designed. All of us are designed and shaped by God. Read Genesis 1:26-27, 2:7. He formed us, shaped us, and created us in His image. We aren't an accident or mistake. He consciously designed who you are. He loves you and calls you valuable and precious. Read Isaiah 43:4.

E – Exclusively and Exquisitely Shaped. Read Psalm 139:13-16. Even identical twins, are different. They may look alike, but they are different in thought, words, and personality. Just as no two gems are the same, we are all exclusively designed.

Read Jeremiah 18:1-4. All of our journeys are unique and different. God doesn't work the same in each of our lives. God uses different things in our lives, often painful things, to shape us into the exclusive and exquisite gem He has in mind for us.

Read Isaiah 54:11-12. God is saying to Israel, and to us, "Your afflictions are meant to change you into something beautiful – something valuable to Me." Out of pain, something beautiful forms. God uses irritants of life, to transform us, for a purpose – to shine His light.

M – Made to Shine. In essence, we are all diamonds in the rough. We aren't beautiful yet, but one day we will be. A diamond starts of as a piece of coal, but with lots of heat and pressure and time, diamond crystals are formed. The diamonds still have to get cleaned and polished before they shine. We cannot see the beauty shining from the jewel until it has been cut and polished. And what a painful process that is, but when the shaping and polishing is over, we have a beautiful and radiant gem. God intended for us to shine. **Read Matthew 5:16**, **Philippians 2:14-15**. Although the polishing process isn't easy, it has a purpose. Affliction, when allowed to accomplish its work, brings about a people who shine forth the beauty of Christ's character.
