Easter is All About the LAMB

A lot of people think that Easter is all about a bunny that delivers colored eggs. But Easter is really not about the bunny; it is about the Lamb. In John 1:29, John the Baptist sees Jesus coming toward him and says, *"Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"* Jesus was the sacrificial Lamb.

L – Laid down His life lovingly. He gave Himself lovingly and willingly. Yes, the Jewish leaders plotted, manipulated and lied in order to get Jesus crucified, but Jesus wasn't forced. He went willingly. **Read Isaiah 53:10.** In John 10, where Jesus talks about being the Good Shepherd, He repeatedly says He lays down His life (John 10:11, 14-18). He wasn't a martyr – He was our sacrifice, and He willingly laid down His life for us. **Read 1 John 3:16.**

A – **Absolute perfect sacrifice.** When God instituted sacrifices in the Old Testament, He made it clear that He expected the best. He wouldn't accept a blind, lame or imperfect sacrifice, but one that was perfect and without blemish. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:21, Hebrews 4:15, 1 John 3:5.** Jesus wasn't dying on the cross for any sin He committed; He was sinless, and because He was sinless He could serve as a perfect sacrifice, a perfect substitute to pay for our sins.

M – Man's debt He paid; My debt He paid. Romans 6:23 tells us that *the wages or payment for sin is death....* Hebrews 9:22 tells us that *without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.* Jesus took our place, and He died our death, and He paid the price we deserved to pay. He paid the debt for sin. **Read 1 Peter 1:18-20**. At the Last Supper, Jesus took the cup, gave thanks and offered it to them, and said, *Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.* (Matthew 26:27-28).

B – **Blood atones for me.** His blood paid the price so my sins couls be atoned for. Atonement means "*at-one-ment*." Because of His blood, I can be right with God again (at one with Him). **Read Romans 3:23-25** and **Ephesians 1:7**.

Jesus was the LAMB who showed His love by dying in our place, shedding His blood, so that through Him we can have a restored relationship with God and have eternal life.
