

Stepping Out In Faith Stones

Hebrews 11 is all about putting faith in action. This craft focuses on making a reminder that we can step out in faith because our God is worth following.

Supplies needed:

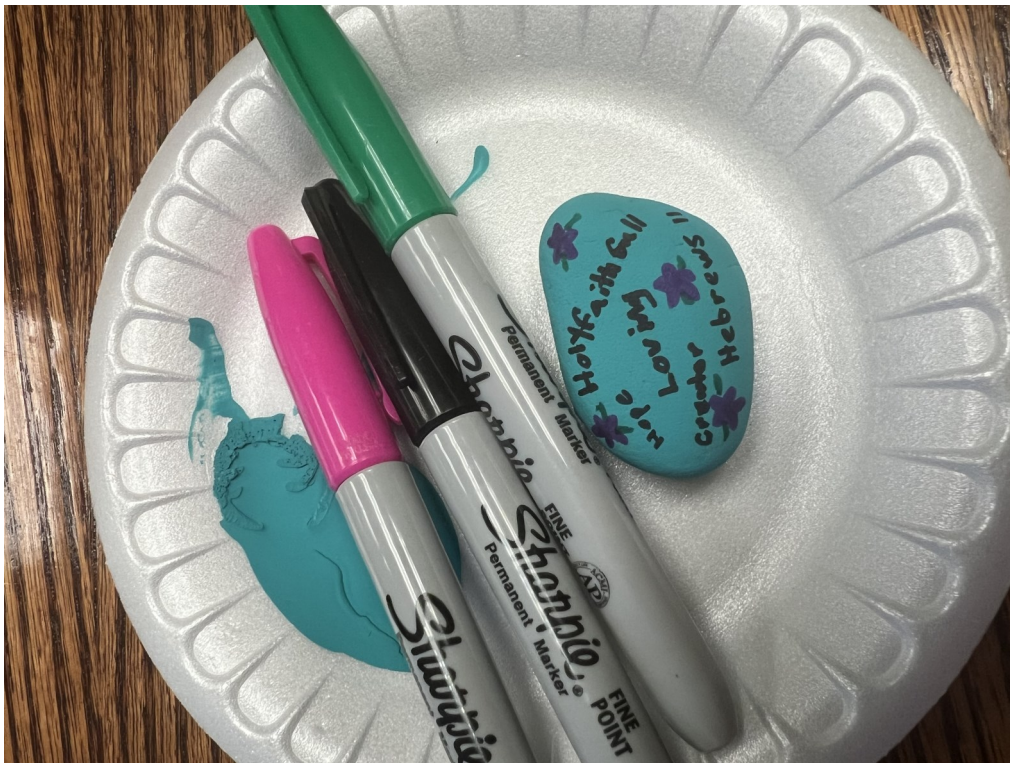
- Medium to large river rocks
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brushes
- Small cups of water
- Paper plates
- Clear Acrylic Sealer
- Color Sharpies (optional)
- Hair dryer (optional)



Start by thoroughly rinsing/washing the rocks off. Make sure they are dry before beginning.



Using the paper plate as a paint palette, and a tray for painting, Select your paint Color/Colors.
 You can choose to do one solid color as seen in the picture, Or Use multiple colors.
 At this point, you will want to let it dry. You can speed up this process by using a hairdryer.



Using Hebrews 11 as inspiration, Decorate the rock to remind you why God is worth following.
 If you have very crafty Ladies, they can paint words or images on their rock.
 You can also use sharpies to write the words or images on the rock.



If the ladies have chosen to paint words or images on the rock it will need to dry before moving to the next step.

Outside or in a well ventilated area, you will spray the finished rocks with clear acrylic sealer.

Note: if you used sharpies, you will want to start the stream away from the rock and bring it to the rock and hold the can at least 2 feet Above the rock.
