

Confident Faith – Confident in God’s Character

Hebrews 11: 1-3, Genesis 1-2

We live in a world that is changing rapidly. We constantly hear of climate change and the need to reverse some of our behaviors for the betterment and sustainability of the earth. Technology is changing at rapid rates to the point where it is hard to keep up. People’s value systems are changing, leaving us vulnerable to the whims of culture. All the changes are sometimes mind numbing.

To try to tell, these lips can only start.

What shakes your confidence? Whatever your answer to that question, we have the assurance that the God who created this world and created us is one in whom we can place our complete confidence. While things around us are constantly changing-God does not. We are reminded in the beautiful song...

Your promise still stands,
Great is your faithfulness, faithfulness
