Scripture: Hebrews 11: 23-29, Exodus 1: 1-22 and Deuteronomy 31-34

Read Exodus 1: 1-22:

1. What is the main issue that the Israelites caused for the Egyptians? (vs. 1-10)
2. When have you felt threatened how do you typically respond?
3. Describe a time in your life when you have felt oppressed?
4. Can you describe a time when you have been courageous like the midwives were in this account ? (vs. 15-22)
5. How have you felt oppressed and how did the Lord come through and help you in your situation?
6. Put your self in Moses's mother, describe how you may have felt knowing that other babies were being thrown in the river Nile?

Read Deuteronomy 32

1. Which verse resonates with you the most and why?
2. Read verse 10, how has the Lord shielded you?
3. Take time to write out your own "song" of praise to God and share with your family/friend?

Read Hebrews 11:23-29

1. Why do you believe that Moses refused to be known as Pharaoh daughter's son? (**vs. 24-26**)
2. When in your life have you felt that perseverance was too challenging and what was the result? (**vs. 27**)
3. Read vs. 29, imagine that you are with the Israelites describe how you are feeling and what you are experiencing?
4. Overall, Moses's story is a powerful reminder of how we can put our confidence in God. What is the biggest lesson you take from this Bible study?
