Confident Faith: Consistency in Christ

Like many, I've been inspired by the recent Winter Olympics. I love watching athletes display such extraordinary discipline, passion, and perseverance. I've always wished I were more athletic myself, but it has never come naturally. This past year, I discovered pickleball—a wonderful beginner-friendly sport for those of us who aren't naturally inclined toward athletics.

I'll admit, my first few weeks on the court were humbling. I chased the ball far more than I ever hit it. And while I've improved some, consistency is still not my strength. I don't always put in the practice needed, so I often repeat the same mistakes. It can be discouraging. Deep down, I want the results without the discipline.

If I'm honest, I sometimes approach my spiritual life the same way. I long for a deeper relationship with Christ, yet I find myself repeating familiar struggles. I want spiritual maturity—but without the daily commitment.

Hebrews 13:8 reminds us:

“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.” He is perfectly consistent—steady, unchanging, and reliable. His faithfulness becomes the foundation for our growth. And unlike us, **He never grows impatient** with our slow steps toward maturity.

When spiritual inconsistency begins to weigh on your heart. Here are a few simple practices to help cultivate steady, Christ-centered consistency:

- **Set aside daily time with God.** Even a few focused minutes can anchor your day.
- **Build spiritual habits** like journaling, gratitude, and quiet reflection.
- **Stay rooted in community** where encouragement and accountability can flourish.
- **Hold fast to the truth** that you are fully and deeply loved by God.

Consistency doesn't mean doing everything flawlessly:

Consistency is showing up—faithfully, even imperfectly—over time.

And when our consistency falters, we rest in the One whose consistency never does. **Consistency in Christ deepens our roots, strengthens our character, and builds resilience.**


