Items need:

- Candle wax
- Wax jar or any pots
- Candle wicks
- Candle wick stickers
- Centering device
- Glass jar for a candle
- *Wax dyes (optional)
- *Fragrance oil (optional)
- *Candle decoration stickers or



Instructions

Put wax into the pots and melt the wax.



When wax is melted then add the color dyes and fragrance oil (optional).



While the candle is melting, prepare the candle with the candle wick and put the centering device



When candle wax is fully melted, then cooling down until it is warm enough to touch.



Pour the wax into the jar and let it cool down.



When the wax turns solid then cut the wick and decorate the jar with the stickers that you wishes or any other decorating supplies.



Then the candle is ready.
